Potsdam the most impressive way: by bike, kayak or standupboard

Potsdam needs to be discovered in the fresh air! The former summer residence of the Prussian kings has been transformed over the centuries into an expansive work of art, a stunning summer retreat. This ensemble is traversed by the lake district of the Havel River and framed by glacial mountain ranges and reaches far into the idyllic surroundings.

Pedales makes it easy to discover this idyll cycling or paddling in many ways.

Directly located in the railway stations Potsdam Main Station and Griebnitzsee Station Potsdam visitors will find our bicycle rental stores. Each guest receives a free cycling map with a marked cycling route through Potsdam. On this route there are not only the great sights such as the castles of Sanssouci and Cecilienhof, but also hidden places and other interesting locations of history.

A completely new feature is the free audio guide for cyclists, which you can be downloaded as an app in German and English on your smartphone. 24 listening stations spoken by actors give a well-founded and humorous insight into the history of Potsdam which has always been a bit of world history. Of course, these and other tours are also offered with "real" guides.

Pedales also operates a paddling station at Griebnitzsee Railway Station. Kayaks, canoes, StandUpBoards: all this can be rented directly here and can be used for short or extended tours on the water. After all, Lake Griebnitzsee is connected to the entire lake district off the Havel River as well as to Lake Wannsee in the direction of Berlin. Since Griebnitzsee is quite sheltered from the wind, it is also the ideal spot for stand-up paddling. The tour program of the paddling station ranges from guided tours, paddling courses to SUP-Yoga.
